

'Plastic Ocean' is an award winning film documentary about the scale and effect of plastic waste in our oceans and aimed at educating us and inspiring us to care and to work for change in our world before it really is too late. Until we know about something we cannot do anything about it. Come and see this beautifully crafted film and the amazing people trying to open the eyes of the world to a large, silent and invisible crisis that affects us all, and about which we can make a difference. The screening of the film will be at St Mary's Church on **Tue 3 October from 7.45pm**. All welcome.

The Bundle - an asylum seeker's story, will take place at **2pm on Sunday 1 October** at Ealing Quaker Meeting House, 17 Woodville Road, W5 2SE. Performed by Journeymen Theatre, it is the story of Adilah, who was abducted into a forced marriage and subjected to a life of servitude. She fled to the UK but encountered the Home Office's 'hostile environment' towards asylum seekers and refugees. Entry is free and a collection will be taken for Ealing Equality Council.

There will be a training event on how to spot modern slavery in car washes on **23 October, 10.30am to 3.30pm** at Church House.
