

POLYGON GIFT DAY

“What a gift day it was last Sunday! Praise God for his goodness and heartfelt thanks to all who gave so generously. We were seeking £250,000 and on the day pledges amounted to £249,804.75 and not all of envelopes had been received at that point. This amount included tax back. This means we can now press ahead with the tender process and for works to start next July. Thank you for this amazing response. Although this is fantastic news we already know that to do all the works needed will cost more than the current £350,000 we have promised. So please keep praying for the necessary resources to complete these works and please keep the envelopes coming in. We would be enormously grateful for all outstanding responses, they are most definitely needed. Please put them in the red bucket after church, hand them into the office in the week or give them to one of the wardens or Steve. Thank you.”
