CONFIRMATION SERVICE

Are you Baptised and Confirmed? If you are not Baptised or you were Baptised as an infant, Confirmation by a Bishop, enables you to get Baptised or own your Infant Baptism for yourself, by making the vows and decision to follow Christ and the declaration of faith in God, Father, Son and Holy Spirit, for yourself as an adult publicly. For example "I was Baptised and brought up as a Christian under the faith of my parents - but now this is my faith too."
