If you can answer yes to all these questions you may be able to live in a flat of the almshouse charity of St Mary's Church in South Ealing. We have 14 flats located in Church Gardens W5 4HL, and we sometimes have vacancies for suitable applicants for our flats.

We provide 12 one-bedroom flats; one wheel chair accessible onebedroom flat; and one two-bedroom wheel chair accessible flat with a room for a carer on the first floor. Each of the flats has a living room, kitchen and a separate bathroom.

The flats are centrally heated and the kitchens and bathrooms are fully fitted. Carpets are also provided, but residents must provide their own furniture and other contents. Each flat is completely self-contained. Eight are on the ground floor and six are on the first floor of the main block. There are attractive communal gardens and the block is close to all amenities. South Ealing tube station and associated transport links are within 200 yards.

Almshouse residents make monthly maintenance contributions (MMCs) for the cost of managing and maintaining their flats. At the moment the MMCs at St Mary's Homes are £300 per month except for the two wheel chair accessible flats for which the MMCs are higher. Housing Benefit can cover the MMCs for those unable to meet these costs themselves.

The almshouse is run by volunteer trustees and is led by Rev. Steve Paynter from St Mary's Church, who chairs the board of trustees.
