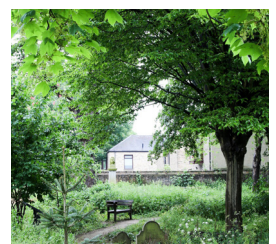
In these challenging times it is even more important to come together in prayer, for our families, friends and neighbours, communities and nations, that the Kingdom
