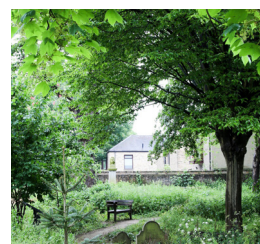
Educare - Family Support Service Ltd deliver food packages to families in need in Ealing. Since the lockdown this has increased with people losing their jobs. Naomi who works for them is also a trustee at Ealing Soup Kitchen and has created a go fund me page as they are getting short of funds.

People from our team and from a neighbourhood whatsapp group have been busy delivering for them - the food packages are particularly good because they include fresh produce like milk and veg that you can't get from the food bank as well as nappies etc.

They seem to be getting increasing numbers of referrals - often delivering 30 parcels a day.
