St Mary's church is now open for private prayer on Tuesdays 10am - 1pm and Thursdays 1pm - 4pm

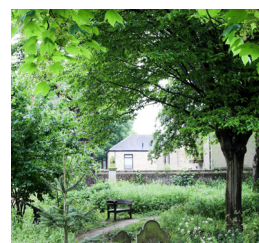


SERMON SERIES - We have finished our sermon series on 1 Peter and are moving on to Peter's second letter which we will be studying throughout July,
