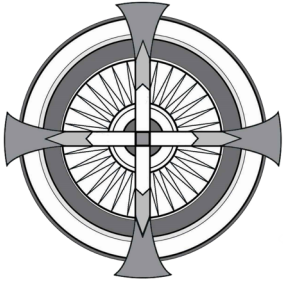

SERMON SERIES

During Creation Time we shall be having services focussing on Climate Sunday, Eco Church and the work of A Rocha, ending with our Harvest Celebrations on October 3. Then our sermons will be based on the theme of JESUS OUR HOPE, which will take us up to Advent.

Grange School, along with other schools in the Borough, are aiming to establish a School Streets Scheme. This means stopping parents entering Church Gardens and Church Place to drop off children between 8.30-9.30am and 2.45-3.45pm by car. This will lower toxic car fumes in the area and make it safer and easier for children to walk and cycle around the school. However, they need a complement of volunteers to stand at the entry and exit points by St. Mary's.
