South Ealing Community Food Cupboard (SECFC) operates in the old vestry and flower room, access from outside; 1 - 3 pm on Mondays (**except bank holidays**). The SEC Food Cupboard is set up to reduce waste. Volunteers receive surplus food from the supermarkets that would otherwise go to landfill (e.g. via Felix Project) and makes it available to anyone and everyone from the local area. The SEC Food Cupboard is available to all – it's aim is purely to reduce waste and associated carbon emissions and everyone can help with that. Always Free!

If you think you can help, or know you definitely can't - please let Angela know asap, she is away the week before so needs to get things organised.

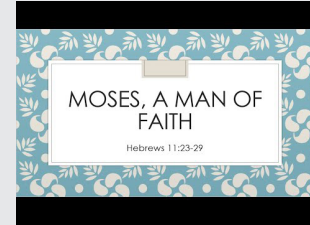
